We are asking you to protect yourselves, your families and our community

Please stay home!

If you have a cough, runny nose, fever, stay home and monitor yourself.

Only come to the Espanola Hospital Emergency Department if you are experiencing moderate to severe symptoms such as shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.

If you are returning from travel, you **must** stay home for 14 days, even if you do not have symptoms of illness.

If you know somebody who is returning from travel please tell them to stay home.

Do not go out unless you have to.
