

Things to know when coming to our hospital

- All outpatient services require an appointment – (Lab, X-ray, Physio, Cardiac Lab & Specialist Clinics)
- Please <u>do not</u> come to the hospital with your requisition to make an appointment in person as you will be redirected to call from home.
- To maintain a good patient flow and reduce numbers in waiting areas, <u>do not</u> come more than 10 minutes before your appointment. If you do, you will be asked to wait outside

Every person entering our facility must:

- Be screened
- Wear a mask
- Sanitize hands

If you do not wish to comply with these protocols you will be denied access.

Visitor Access

Emergency Department:

- One dedicated visitor per patient
- All visitors will be screened upon entry to the hospital, if they screen positive to the screening questions entry will be denied
- Patients and family/caregivers presenting to the ED are asked to bring their own mask, if they do not have one then one will be provided
- Mask are to be worn at all times while in the hospital
- Perform hand hygiene upon entering and exiting the hospital
- Physical distancing is to be maintained while in the hospital

Acute Care:

- Visiting hours: 11:00-14:00 and 17:00-19:00
- One family member/caregiver per patient at a time
- All visitors will be screened upon entry to the hospital, if they screen positive to the screening questions entry will be denied
- Family members/caregivers provide their own mask, if possible
- Masks are to be worn at all times while in hospital
- Perform hand hygiene upon entering and exiting the hospital
- Physical distancing to be maintained while in hospital

**Special consideration for palliative and critically ill patients will be given by the Clinical Team.
